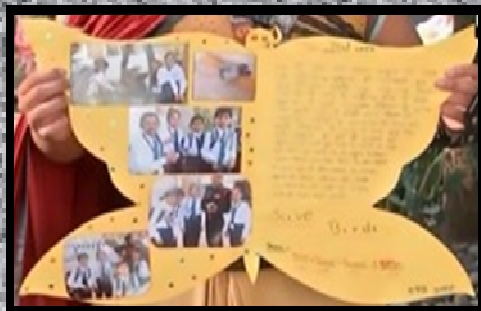
A Visit to Sayan Sugar Factory
